Coumarins (2H-1-benzopyran-2-ones) are important oxygen containing fused heterocycles used in drugs and dyes owing to the immense significance and diverse activities exhibited by compounds. Efforts have been made to generate libraries of coumarin derivative and screen them for potential microbial activities. - B. Microbial Study of the coumarin.

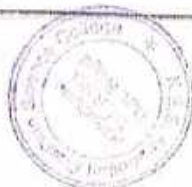
Rationale for taking up project:

active compounds, it is important to find 'facile practical approach for synthesis of coumarin and their derivatives. It includes the synthesis of coumarin and their derivatives by convenient method.

Some newer coumarin and their derivatives were synthesized by About 150 ml. of conc. Powdered resorcinol was added to ethyl acetoacetate until a complete solution was obtained. Then this solution was added slowly to pre cooled H<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub>. In such a way that the temperature does not rise above 100C and the stirring was continued for 30 minutes. The mixture is poured into the ice cold water & the solid product is separated, filtered out and dried. Then the crude product was recrystallized from ethanol.

Therefore, in this study, common route for the synthesis of coumarin and their derivatives compounds. To improve the maximum conversion of starting material into product and speed up the reaction, various other catalysts or reagents have been reported.

These coumarin and their derivatives have been characterized by Elemental analysis and spectral data IR, <sup>1</sup>HNMR C13 and MS.





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
